Our Annual General Meeting will be held on Thursday, 20th October at 7pm at The Pavilion, Castle Green, followed by a light supper provided by the Friends – bring a bottle. IMPORTANT FUNDING UPDATE

This Newsletter has been a little delayed because we have been waiting for the go ahead from the Awards for All funding team to *MAKE AN ANNOUCEMENT!* From 11th October we have been given permission to make the following news public.

We have been told that our Awards for All funding bid has been successful & the Friends of Castle Green has been awarded £10,000 to run city-wide consultation events, based primarily in the Pavilion. Specifically we shall run:

- 2 project promotion days in the High Town area of Hereford city centre.
- 14 World Cafe events, each for 30 people, to incorporate an in-depth presentation followed by small group discussions on the challenges, risks and opportunities for the future of Castle Green.
- 3x Planning for Real consultations, that would coincide with our large, open-air and free to attend public events, to capture the views and opinions of up to 10,000 people. This element would include displays of ideas and strategies emerging from the World Cafe events.

Following these events, the Friends of Castle Green will undertake analysis of the results of the consultation and publish a report of the

findings. This report will form the basis of detailed representations to Herefordshire Council's Forward Planning Team in order to ensure the findings' inclusion in the Hereford Area Plan.

We are really excited by the success of this funding application. We are poised to take over the Pavilion on a permanent basis and this project will allow us to plan for the long term future of the Pavilion & the Castle Green and to start to develop community business models that will help create sustainable long term income for the area.

So a BIG THANK YOU must go to Joy Harvey our newest member on the Director team for getting the bid in so successfully! There will be bags more detail of the project at out AGM on 20th October (as well as a great supper - please bring a bottle!).
