We've at last heard from the Council that things are moving on our Community Asset Transfer application to take on the Castle Green Pavilion building. If we are successful, it will mean we will be able to apply for significant grant funding not available to us currently due to our temporary tenure.

Funding is key if we are to regenerate the building and Green to help deliver the vision for a space of celebration, education, recreation.

Floats, fishes and fun for a River Carnival to remember Hereford River Carnival returns to Castle Green for 2016 extravaganza

On Saturday 30th April 2016, Hereford's River Carnival will return to Castle Green and with more activities, competitions and all round fun, it promises to be bigger and better than ever.

The Carnival with its street processions, amazing puppet creations, food, drink, music and rafts on the Wye will take place on Castle Green, Bishop's Meadow, the Left Bank and this year will also venture into the city streets for its colourful foot procession.

The River Carnival has been so successful since its return in 2014, after a 40 year absence, that the organisers expect there to be even more than the 7,000 people and over 70 local groups involved last year that will take part in 2016.

According to Jo Henshaw, one of the Carnival's organisers, "Last year was a great success thanks to everyone who took part and supported the event. Hereford turned out in force and we were once again hugely grateful to the Friends of Castle Green for their support and all the massive effort you put in. The Fun Dog Show was a roaring (or should that be barking) success and the stalls and acts on the Green make it a real focal point for the Carnival. We would like to say a big thank you to FOCG and we hope very much that even more of you will get involved this year."

There are so many ways to get involved. This year, the organisers have set a challenge for the people of Hereford to get crafty and make a special origami fish to form part of a massive 10,000 strong shoal which will be assembled on Bishop's Meadow during the Carnival fun.

Plus, with a £3,000 grant from Hereford City Council for the 2016 Carnival announced last month which includes £250 for the best decorated raft, the organisers hope that the cash prize will encourage more people to take part and greater competition among the rafts.
