WORDS FROM THE CHAIR

It is incredible to think that in 2004, when the Friends was first formed, the only event to be held regularly on Hereford's Castle Green was the Trooping of the Colour for a few hours each year. Eight years later......

2012 has been an amazing year for events, our Diamond Day celebration in June was attended by a HUGE crowd from across the city, we have had fundraising walks in aid of Guide Dogs for the Blind, Historical Hereford Day, a theatre production of 'Private Lives', a Wizards & Cloisters day, the hugely successful Allpay Flavours of Herefordshire Festival and numerous other events both organised and impromptu! The Friends have certainly put the Castle Green on the map for community events that can be enjoyed by all.

It is a mark of our success that we have now been entrusted with developing plans for the Old Art College building. We have signed a temporary tenancy on the building and put together a steering group, largely made up of local people with the set of skills we are going to need to restore the building to its Georgian splendour and develop a real community hub for Hereford City.

To make a truly sustainable project work in such austere times will be difficult, but not impossible. With your help we can make this happen, so here are two things you can do to help:

COME TO THE CHRISTMAS FAYRE – not just because it is a great day out, with a brilliant Christmas Market for those locally sourced gifts and presents, but also because the building will be open to the public for the first time in many years. CASTLE GREEN YOUTH CANOE CENTRE IN PERIL!

The budget cuts at Herefordshire Council are really beginning to bite and one of the first casualties is set to be the outdoor river activities run for young people on the Castle Green. Started in the late 1960's by volunteer and local man, Vic Gammage, there has been a centre where the young people of Hereford can access cheap, good quality instruction on using canoes on the River Wye ever since.

Sadly the Council have decided they can no longer afford to run the service and it is set to be closed at the end of the financial year.

Luckily this has coincided with the Friends of Castle Green bid to take over the building it is run from and we have given a clear commitment to keeping the service running. Talks can now begin to find a way of financing the service, with local man and entrepreneur, Will Vaughan (of Pedicab fame) stepping in to help steer and advise. Volunteer Vic has also joined the steering group for the building project and has also vowed to keep the service going.

Things are going to be tight for the next couple of years, but if we put the right package together and attract a decent level of funding, we should be able to provide this valuable service for years to come!
